## Changes to Our "Normal" Operation.

Throughout Birthday Week, you will be sent daily operational updates informing you of any changes to facility usage and alternative arrangements in case of bad weather.

For the duration of the Birthday Week access to the Club will be via Warreners Lane and access into the Club will be via the Terrace gate, due to the construction of our Ball marquee. Reception will operate as normal and can be accessed via the internal route.

All Tennis, Squash and Swimming lessons will continue as normal.

## Monday 5th June: - Summer Soiree & Supper

- Only the Club Room menu will be available in the Lake Room. Last food orders will need to be made by 2pm, with the Lake Room closed from 3pm for the event.
- All other Facilities open as normal.
- Parking may be limited from 6.30pm due to the numbers attending the event.

## Tuesday 6th June: - Big Quiz Night

- Only the Club Room menu will be available in the Lake Room. Last food orders will need to be made by 2pm, with the Lake Room closed from 3pm for the event.
- Bridge will be taking place in the Tarrant Room from 6pm to 9.30pm.
- All other Facilities will be open as normal.

## Wednesday: - 7th June: Birthday Drinks Reception

- Lake Room service will be unavailable all day.
- Club Room and BBQ (weather permitting) menu will be on offer all day.
- Bridge will be taking place in the Tarrant Room from 6pm to 9.30pm.
- All other Facilities open as normal.
- Parking will be very limited from 6.30pm.  
Please, where possible, park outside of the Estate and walk to the Club.

## Thursday 8th June: - Summer Beach BBQ

- Lake Room service will be unavailable all day.
- Club Room and BBQ (weather permitting) menu will be on offer all day.
- All other Facilities will be open as normal.
- Terrace tables are available to book for the evening event.
- Parking will be very limited from 5pm.

### Friday 9th June: - Live DJ Night

- All facilities (Club Room, Gym, Pool, Spa, Squash and Tennis Courts) close at 5pm and the Club closes at 6pm; reopening at 7.30pm for DJ Night, ticket holders only.
- Lake Room service will be unavailable all day.
- Club Room and BBQ (weather permitting) menu will be on offer until 4pm in the Club Room and on the Terrace. Please remember, the Club closes at 6pm, we stop serving food from 5pm.

### Saturday 10th June: - Birthday Ball Event

- All facilities (Club Room, Gym, Pool, Spa, Squash and Tennis courts) close at 5pm and the Club closes at 6pm.
- Lake Room service will be unavailable all day.
- Club Room and BBQ (weather permitting) menu on offer until 4pm in the Club Room and on the Terrace, closes at 5pm.
- There is no overnight parking.

### Sunday 11th June: - Family Fun day

- All facilities (Lake Room, Club Room, Gym, Pool, Spa, and Squash) close at 11am and the Club and Tennis Courts close at 12 noon; Club re-opens for Family Fun Day ticket holders at 1pm.
- All cars must be removed from the Club grounds by 12noon.
- No parking available, other than for disabled persons.

**Car Parking:** - There will be extremely limited parking for members and guests attending our Friday DJ Night and Saturday Birthday Ball. There is NO parking on our Family Fun Day, Sunday.

Due to the numbers of people attending the events, it is not possible for us to provide adequate car parking for all;

1. If you need to drive because of distance, please be aware that once all the spaces in the Club's restricted car park have been taken, you will have to park outside of the Estate on neighbouring streets and walk into the Club. The only available entrance that this is possible is Old Avenue and surrounding roads. Should you have to park outside of the Estate, please do remember to be considerate to our neighbours' driveways, adhere to any parking restrictions and, should you return to your vehicle late at night, please respect that our neighbours who may be asleep.
2. **Parking on Estate roads and verges is not permitted.**
3. If you are arriving by taxi, or chauffeur-driven car, there will be a turning circle in the Club car Park where we will welcome you to the event. Please remember to make suitable arrangements for the time you wish to be picked up at the end of the evening, remembering that both the Friday and Saturday night events, your taxi must arrive by 1am sharp. Entrance to the Estate is only via Old Avenue and the Brooklands entrance. We recommend using KT13 0PX to guide you to the entrance on Old Avenue.

5. Entrance to the Club for all traffic during this period, will only be via the Warreners Lane entrance. No cars to be left overnight in our car parks on the Saturday night. Any car found to be an obstruction will be removed.
